## Sepulveda Tunnel Renovation Project utilizes Sequoia Lighting Products

In order to meet current IES Roadway Lighting Standards, the tunnel's existing light sources required upgrading with brighter and more efficient lighting.

Since the luminaires in the tunnel were imbedded in the tunnel's ceiling, special retrofit products were needed. Additionally, the harsh environment found in the tunnel necessitated the use of weatherproof components in the new fixtures. Sequoia's engineering department worked with LABSL engineers on the design of the new, custom retrofit luminaires.

Engineering, fabrication and installation of the new light fixtures for the Sepulveda Tunnel was completed in approximately one month.

The new lighting in the Sepulveda Tunnel has resulted in safer driving conditions for LA motorists. Lighting levels now exceed current safety standards set forth by the IES and other governing agencies.
